# **Parking Lot Violations**

- Unsafe Driving:
  - Depending on severity of offense permit will be pulled for a defined length of time with or without further school or police action
- Parking without a permit/parking in unassigned parking spot:
  - 1st offense: parent contact and sticker warning
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> offense: car will be ticketed by Plainfield Police Dept.
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> offense: progressive ticketing with possible tow

## ID'S:

- MUST BE CARRIED WITH YOU AT ALL TIMES!
  - Need them to purchase lunch and for tardies.
- Temporary ID's are \$1. See Mrs. Maher in student services, 1413.
- If purchasing a Temp ID becomes continuous, must purchase a new id for \$5.

## **DRESS CODE**

- Arms can be exposed from the tip of the shoulder to the ends of the hands.
- Non revealing neckline
- No bare midriffs or backs are permitted. The stomach and back cannot be revealed while engaged in normal school activity like sitting, and/or working at the board in class
- Pants should be worn at the waist as intended-could be sent to the Raptor desk
- Shorts, skirts, and dresses are to extend to approximately mid thigh.
- Hats are to be left in your locker during the school day.
- Do not carry hats or attach to bag.

  - Forming of special sites to belittle others BULLY HOTLINE- Anonymous

### **Event Behavior**

- Superfans are encourage to attend all extracurricular/sporting events
- · All school rules apply to all home and away events
- Inappropriate behavior could lead to disciplinary action and/or removal from event(s)
- Social probation

### Survival Skills

- Building Hours/Loitering: Students not involved in a school sponsored activity or with a teacher are expected to leave the building by 2:30.
- Cafeteria: Students are responsible for disposing of his/her own trash and displaying appropriate lunch room behavior. Violations may result in consequences from Dean. No food or drink outside of the cafeteria before, during, or after school.
- Bus Transportation: Students must obey driver at all times. Students are to get on and exit the bus at their assigned stop

### Survival Skills cont.

- Failure to Identify: A student's refusal to identify, or falsely identify themselves, may be result in suspension
- Hat Policy: Students (males and females) are not allowed to
  wear the hat during the academic day. Hats are to be left in your
  locker. That means they can wear the hat after school, and at
  athletic events in or outside. They must however, wear the hat
  with the bill straight forward or straight backwards. The hat can
  not be tilted to one side or the other, if they do then they must
  either remove the hat or leave our property. This covers do-rags
  and bandanas as well.
- Confiscated Items: School ID is needed in order to pick up any item confiscated.

## Survival Skills cont.

- Electronic devices are not allowed in either cafeteria
- Ear buds are not allowed in the hallway
- If students want to go to the Media Center they must have a yellow pass from an academic teacher and their current ID for attendance scanning.
- Students will need to report directly to the Media Center and get there before the bell. DO NOT go to study hall first.
