Reminder all students must wear an approved District 202 FIT FOR LIFE shirt for their PE Class. Students must also use a school-issued lock and will be assigned a locker. Heart Rate Monitor Straps are available for a minimal cost and can be used in all physical education classes. There will be straps available but we encourage each student to buy their own for safety reasons.

No Loitering

Students are not allowed to loiter in the building after school hours for any reason, including waiting for practice or events to start. Students must be picked up within 30 minutes of their events end.

Attendance Procedures

To report a student's absence, call 815/436-3260. **Calls must be received before 10:00 am.** You will be asked to provide the following information:

- 1) Student Name
- 2) Student ID #
- 3) Date and reason for absence
- 4) Student birthday
- 5) Name of person calling
- 6) Phone number we can reach the person calling for verification.

If a student needs to

be signed out early, for any reason you will be asked the same information. **Please call at least an hour before your student needs to leave the building.**

When the call is received for a student to leave the building, a pass will be issued to the student. The student must sign out at the Raptor Desk in the main building. The more time you allow the better. A parent will need to come in to show an ID to sign the

student out unless the student drives. **Parents can expect to wait if we have to find your student without notice.** Students in PE would need to change clothes and other classes could be in other locations during the school day. Calling ahead will prevent a wait time that could cause you to be late for your appointment. Notes from parents are not accepted.

Start of School Reminders

Lockers

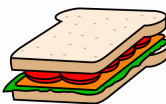
Students may not share lockers at PHS.

Student ID's

All students must carry their current PHS ID in order to enter the media center, buy lunch or attend any athletic event. Students will not be allowed to enter an athletic event without an ID. Middle school students wishing to enter a PHS athletic event must have an ID and be accompanied by their parent. A replacement ID can be purchased for \$5 from Student Services.

Food

No food will be delivered



to students during the school day. Students must bring all food in with them when they come to school. Any food brought in will be held in the office until the end of the school day.

Cell Phones



Cell phones

are not allowed during the school day. If your student is caught with their cell phone out it will be confiscated. First time offenders may pick them up after school with their current ID. Parents will be required to pick up phones of repeat offenders.

Busses

Make sure your student remembers their route and bus number, and if they get picked up on the East or West side of the building.

Building Temperature

Curriculum Night

The faculty and staff at Plainfield High School invite you to attend Curriculum Night on Wednesday, August 30, 2017. You will follow an abbreviated version of your student's schedule and meet his/her teachers. This evening is for parents/guardians only - no students please. A Drivers Ed meeting is scheduled for 10th grade parents at 6:00 pm in the Auditorium. Early Bird classes begin at 6:40 pm everyone else begins the evening at 7 pm.

Textbooks

Your student will be assigned a specific textbook by his/her teacher. At the end of the semester (for semester classes) or at the end of the school year, your student must turn in the exact book he/she

was given and in good condition in order to avoid fines. Remind your student that they must hand the book back to the teacher. **Books left by students in lockers, or lying on counters or desks, may**

cause a bill to be generated to the student for the replacement cost of the book. A restocking fee may also be assessed for books left in student lockers.

Student Drivers/Parking

A permit is required to park on school property. Students must meet eligibility requirements to obtain a permit. Permits can be obtained from Student Services for \$100.00.

A reminder to students who drive, car problems, road congestion and bad weather are not excused absences.



Parking Permits Required

Students are encouraged to leave home a little earlier to get to school on time or take the bus. Students are expected to arrive safely and on time.

Student Accident Insurance
