# Six Flags Trip

## The basics

- The Six Flags trip will be on Saturday, May 12 and will return on Mother's Day morning.
- We will depart from the front of PHS at 7:30 PM and buses will leave as soon as students are checked in. If the buses are loaded and a student is not present, the buses will not wait for those who show up late. Students are expected to be back on the bus at 2:30 AM and can expect to arrive back at PHS between 3:30 and 4:00 AM.
  - Six Flags does not allow people to arrive at the park in cars (for safety reasons)- if you plan on going, you must take the bus.
- The cost of the ticket is \$55, which includes the park ticket and bus ride. Food will be available for purchase at Six Flags.
- Note: Six Flags considers this a special event and season passes are not honored.

# Rules to be aware of

- This is a school-sponsored trip- all school rules apply, and breaking any rules could result in school discipline as well as not being allowed to 'walk' at graduation.
- **Anyone who appears to be impaired, intoxicated, etc.,**
  - Before the trip- will not be allowed to board the bus and is subject to not walking at graduation.
  - During the trip- will have to call someone to pick you up from the park and subject to not walking at graduation.
- You must bring your driver's license in case the chaperone who checks you in does not know you.

# Buying tickets- (Seniors only; no dates)

- You can buy tickets at <https://statechamps.com/clients/phscc/> or you may go to [www.statechamps.com](http://www.statechamps.com) and search for our school, but you will need to install the app because you will receive an e-ticket that will be swiped on your device when you're boarding the bus.
- You will select the bus that you will sit on when purchasing your ticket- be sure to communicate this to your friends if you'd like to sit with them.
- Six Flags requires full payment from PHS no later than April 23, so tickets must be purchased no later than April 20.

# More about buying tickets

- Students may buy tickets for multiple students at the same time if paying with the same credit card- make sure both the full names and ID numbers for each student are entered at the time of purchase.
- As of now, 5 buses (220 tickets) have been set up on the State Champs website. If these tickets sell out with at least 1 week before the deadline, study hall teachers will receive instructions to communicate with the seniors as to whether we'll open up more tickets and another bus along with 44 tickets. If sales are strong early enough, we can sell up to 300 tickets.

# Social Probation

# Senior Banquet (Seniors only; no dates)

- The banquet will be held at Prairie Bluff Golf Course (Renwick road between Weber and Route 53) on Thursday, May 17 from 6:00-10:00 PM.
  - If you have an athletic event on that date, see Mr. Coventry in person, as you will have a different situation with tickets that cannot be handled online.
- The cost will be \$30 and tickets will go on sale Monday, March 19, and will be sold until the 187 seats are filled (that is the maximum capacity of the venue).

# Ordering tickets

- You can buy tickets at <https://statechamps.com/clients/phscc/> or you may go to [www.statechamps.com](http://www.statechamps.com) and search for our school, but you will need to install the app because you will receive an e-ticket that will be swiped on your device when you're entering the banquet hall.
- When ordering, you will get to choose your table number (so make sure your friends know this when signing up). However, 9 seats is the maximum per table, so you may be wise to have friends buy tickets on the same day. You may also choose to sign up for a higher table number instead of taking the first available number, especially if you have more than 4 friends sitting together.
  - Also, please note when signing up for your table- you will have a choice of the standard (beef) dinner or you may choose a vegan or vegetarian option. Be sure to click on the entrée type you require.
