ART FOUNDATIONS

- 2- 6B drawing pencils
- 2-4 paper blending stumps of various sizes
- 1- kneaded eraser
- 1- white vinyl eraser
- 2- ball point pens .07mm
- 1-12 or 24 set of colored pencils
- 1-9x12 drawing tablet
- 1 - Sarpie twin tip, black

ADVANCED DRAWING

- 2- 6B drawing pencils
- 2-4 paper blending stumps of various sizes
- 1- kneaded eraser
- 1- white vinyl eraser
- 2- ball point pens .07mm
- 1-12 or 24 set of colored pencils (Prismacolor is recommended)
- 1-12 or 24 set of soft, chalk pastels
- 1-12 set of watercolor paints
- 1-9x12 drawing tablet
- 1 - Sarpie twin tip, black

PAINTING

- 8-10 Canvases (as needed per project, needs to be bigger than 9x12)
- 1-12 set of watercolor paints
- Acrylic paints including at least red, yellow, green, blue, violet, orange, brown, white, black
- 1-3 Watercolor brushes
- 1-3 acrylic brushes
- 1- roll of masking tape or artist tape
