The Plainfield Community Consolidated School District 202, Plainfield Central High School, and the Plainfield Police Department have partnered to create an electronic device registration program for students and staff. This program is a proactive crime prevention measure designed to address the potential problem of electronic device thefts in our school. Students and staff will be able to register their electronic devices with Detective Malcolm by filling out an [electronic device registration form](#). This form will collect the serial number, make, model, color, and a brief description of the student's electronic device. Each electronic device must be present at the time of the registration. The information will be entered into a database which will be accessible to the police and school administration. Students will also undergo a brief counseling session regarding theft prevention and receive a theft prevention tips handout. The pre-registration of electronic device is not meant to replace a theft report, but it will act as another tool in the investigation of any stolen or missing item, and perhaps serve as a deterrent to prevent some thefts.
