Attendance Procedures

To report a student's absence, call 815/436-3260. **Calls must be received before 10:00 am.** Student attendance will be taken during online learning. You will be asked to provide the following information:

- 1) Student Name
- 2) Student ID #
- 3) Date and reason for absence
- 4) Student birthday
- 5) Name of person calling
- 6) Phone number we

Once school begins in person, if a student needs to be signed out early for any reason, you will be asked the same information. **Please call at least an hour before your student needs to leave the building.** When the call is received for a student to leave the building, a pass will be issued to the student. No Loitering

Students are not allowed to loiter in the building after school hours for any reason, including waiting for practice or events to start.

Building Temperature

Once school begins, whether the air or heat are on the temperature in the building varies from hallway to hallway. Some areas in the building will be colder than others. Dress in layers to keep from getting too hot or too cold. Sweaters and sweatshirts are good options to carry. Blankets are not allowed in the building and may not be used to keep warm.

Student ID's

All students must carry their current PHS ID in order to enter the media center, buy lunch or attend any athletic event. Students will not be allowed to enter an athletic event without an ID. Cell Phones

Cell phones are not allowed during instructional time. If your student is caught with their cell phone out it will be confiscated. First time offenders may pick them up after school with their current ID. Parents will be required to pick up phones of repeat offenders.

Busses

Make sure your student remembers their route and bus number once school begins.

No food will be delivered to students during the school day. Students must bring all food in with them when they come to school. Any food brought in will be held in the office until

Textbooks

Your student will be assigned a specific textbook by their teacher. At the end of the semester (for semester classes) or at the end of the school year, your student must turn in the

exact book they were given and in good condition in order to avoid fines. Remind your student that they must hand the book back to the teacher. *Books left by students in lockers, or*

lying on counters or desks, may cause a bill to be generated to the student for the replacement cost of the book. A restocking fee may also be assessed for books left in student lockers.

Student Drivers/Parking

A permit is required to park on school property. Students must meet eligibility requirements to obtain a permit. Once school begins permits can be obtained from Student Services for \$100.00.
