Ticket Information

\$100 per person

Ticket Sales (In Person): March 28, 30 and April 10, 11, 14 after school in the front foyer from 2:15ish to 3:00 pm

To buy a Prom ticket in person, you must have the following items:

- Current Student ID
- All debts paid to the bookkeeper *District Policy*
- If you have a date request form, you must purchase both tickets at the **same time in person**. Your completed date request form is due at the time of ticket purchase.
- A dean-approved Prom Date Request form (only if you are taking a guest from a different school)
- Cash or check payable to Plainfield High School Central Campus
- Patience – this will take time, you need to be patient and plan ahead

Ticket Sales (On-Line): Link will open (hopefully) March 27 and close midnight on April 13 – More details as we get closer to the date.

To buy a Prom ticket online, be aware of these criteria

- Must have a Current Student ID
- All debts paid to the bookkeeper (as of end of day March 23)
- **One ticket per Student ID**
- If you have a guest from outside of PCHS, then you have to purchase in person. Plan accordingly.
- There is a service charge you will be responsible for paying at time of purchase

Please note that prom tickets are **non-transferable** and **non-refundable**.

Table Selection: You will be signing up for a table closer to the day of prom. This will be done on through either Sign-up Genius or a Google Form. One table = 10 people. **Think and Plan Ahead.** If tables are not full, you will be combined with other tables. We need to have full tables.

Friday Attendance Expectations & Ticket Pick-Up

You are expected to come to school on Friday, April 28. PHS administration have agreed that students may **begin** leaving school to prepare for prom after 3rd period (10:06 am).

Upon purchasing your ticket(s), you will be issued a receipt – this is **NOT** your ticket.

Tickets will be picked up by each student in a to be determined location as THEY leave school on Friday.

Failure to attend school on Friday means you will not be allowed into Prom

Prom Guidelines

To ensure that Prom will be a memorable night for everyone involved, it is essential that everyone understands and adheres to the following guidelines:

1. Because Prom is a school-sponsored event, all PHS rules will apply. School rules apply to everyone in attendance, including guests from other schools. Please see the PHS handbook for specific rules.
2. Prom is for PHS students with Junior or Senior class status and one guest of their choosing. Non-PHS Guests must be at least a freshman in high school but no older than twenty (20) years of age to attend Prom.
3. The consumption and/or possession of alcohol, tobacco, or drugs before, during, or after the Prom are strictly prohibited. Students suspected of violating this policy may be searched and/or required to take a breathalyzer test.

4. All students need to keep shoes on his/her feet the entire time you are in the banquet hall. Bring slippers, Crocs, flip flops, etc. if you think you will not be able to stay in your “prom” shoes all night.
5. Once you enter the banquet hall, you will not be allowed back to your car to retrieve shoes, jackets, sweaters, etc.

Date Request Notice:

Plainfield High School Central Campus reserves the right to decline the request for attendance and to request the removal of any PHS or Non-PHS student with or without cause. Attendance at the Prom is a PRIVILEGE and NOT a right.

Only one guest person!

NO EXCEPTIONS!

Date Request Forms must be turned in when you purchase tickets.

Photo I.D. is required for you and your guest. If no I.D. is presented, entrance to Prom will be refused WITHOUT refund of ticket price.
